



MURCO FOUNDATION GRANT GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

The Murco Foundation Fund was established as a donor advised fund within the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin in 1992. The Murco board of directors annually reviews applications and awards grants through the Community Foundation.

ELIGIBILITY

Applications are considered from nonprofit organizations (preferably 501(C)(3) organizations) serving the greater Wausau area and Marathon County, Wisconsin. The focus of its funding is for the **advancement of education and the arts** in our community.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Requests must be submitted electronically by midnight on September 1 for consideration in the grant cycle.

The application is available on the Community Foundation's grant management portal:

If this is your first visit to the online application site, you will need to "Create New Account." If you have registered before, you will enter your email address and password.

Once you are in the system, you will click on the "Apply" button on the left hand column. When you see the menu of application processes, you will choose the "Murco Foundation" application. Save the document occasionally on the bottom of page. Click the "Submit Application" button when you have completed the application.

NOTIFICATION

You will receive notification that your application has been received. At that point, the proposal will be forwarded to the Murco board of directors for review. Applicants will be notified by a representative of the Murco Foundation regarding action taken on requests within 45 days of the application due date.
