

How Do I Participate?

- 1. Go to the Community Foundation website at www.cfoncw.org to register by November 11 and you will receive your first prize entry ticket.
- 2. Attend the Kick-Off Event on Tuesday, November 11, between 5-6 p.m., at the Woodson YMCA Camp Sturtevant, 2701 Northwestern Ave, Wausau, to pick up your CommUNITY Foundation Quest informational packet and task list and complete your first Quest assignment. If you are unable to attend the kick-off, you can pick up your participation packet at any of the participating nonprofit Quest locations or the Community office during the week.
- 3. Plan your course determine which nonprofits you will visit during the week, and plan your shopping list.
- 4. Visit as many of the participating nonprofit locations as you wish throughout the week of November 12-18, 2014 and complete the assigned task/s or make the appropriate donations. Only one ticket will be awarded per person at each site for each task and/or donation completed.
- 5. After you complete a task at each location, you will receive an entry ticket for the door prizes. Make sure your ticket is stamped on the back or punched with Quest site identification.
- 6. Door prize entries will only be awarded between November 12 and 18. Please note the times each organization has listed to be open for Quest participant visits.
- 7. To be eligible to win, all door prize entries must be turned into the Community Foundation office by 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18 OR brought to the Finale Event by 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday the 18th. The Community Foundation is located on the second floor of the Dudley Tower at 500 First Street, Suite 2600, in downtown Wausau.

Plan to attend the CommUNITY Quest Finale Event on Tuesday, November 18, from 5-6 p.m. at the Wausau Curling Club, 1920 Curling Way, Wausau, for an opportunity learn about more nonprofit organizations and earn additional prize entry tickets. Bring your entry tickets to have a chance at the door prizes. Refreshments will be served. The door prize drawing will occur at 5:40 p.m.
