PURPOSE OF THE FUND:

SELECTION GUIDELINES:

- Demonstrating financial need.

ANNOUNCEMENT AND PAYMENT:

If available, a member of the Riiser family will make the presentation of the scholarship award at the awards ceremonies. If not available, a representative of the Community Foundation or NTC will make the presentation on behalf of the Riiser family. The recipients will receive a congratulatory letter from the Community Foundation after the awards ceremony, instructing them on how to initiate their scholarship payment.

Scholarship funds will be paid by the Community Foundation directly to Northcentral Technical College Foundation upon receipt of proof of registration.
