

WILLIAM CHEREK SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

To provide annual scholarships to students of Wittenberg-Birnamwood and Rosholt High Schools, who plan to pursue a post-secondary education in the field of accounting. One recipient can be named from Rosholt High School annually, and two recipients can be named by Wittenberg-Birnamwood High School annually.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Apply online by visiting www.cfoncw.org. Click on “Grants & Scholarships” / “Scholarships” / “Apply Online Now” to reach the online application portal and begin the registration and application process. If this is your first visit to the site, you will need to “Create an Account.” If this is a return visit, enter your email address and password. Choose the appropriate application from the menu.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 1

YOUR APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- Transcript of most recent grades
- List of extracurricular activities (downloadable form online)
- Two reference letters

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Preference for selection of the recipients will be given in the following manner:

First Choice: Able and deserving graduating senior from Wittenberg-Birnamwood or Rosholt High School who plans to pursue an accounting degree and is a member of St. Ladislaus Catholic Church.

Second Choice: Able and deserving graduating senior from Wittenberg-Birnamwood or Rosholt High School who plans to pursue an accounting degree, not necessarily a member of St. Ladislaus Catholic Church.

Third Choice: Able and deserving graduating senior from Wittenberg-Birnamwood or Rosholt High School who is a member of St. Ladislaus Catholic Church, pursuing any field of study.

ANNOUNCEMENT

The recipient will be announced at their high school senior awards ceremony in the spring.

PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will receive a congratulatory letter from the Community Foundation after the awards ceremony, instructing them on how to receive
