



## DEXTER & RUTH CIHLA SCHOLARSHIP

### PURPOSE

To support post-secondary educational opportunities for graduates of Rhinelander High School who plan to attend a four-year college or university.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for consideration, students must complete the general application for scholarships at their high school. Contact the guidance office for application materials and the deadline.

### CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Graduating senior from Rhinelander High School;
- Who is able and deserving;
- Have maintained a strong GPA during high school;
- Demonstrate financial need; and
- Plans to attend an accredited 4-year college or university; with preference given to students planning to attend a UW-state college or university.

Consideration will be given to students who demonstrate:

- Character
- Leadership, and
- Service to their school and community

### ANNOUNCEMENT

The recipients will be announced at the Rhinelander High School senior awards ceremony in the spring.

### PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The recipients will receive a congratulatory letter from the Community Foundation after the awards ceremony instructing them on how to receive their scholarship funding.

The students must provide proof of registration to the Community Foundation office for payment to be initiated. The Foundation will make payment directly to the college or university the students plan to attend.
