

ROGER & MARY PUKALL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE

- 1) To assist Pukall Lumber Company employee's dependent children with the cost of post-secondary education,
- 2) And, to make scholarships available to Lakeland Union High School graduates who plan to enroll in a Wood Technology or Wood Science Program at an accredited technical school.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Apply online by visiting our website at cfoncw.org. Click on "Grants & Scholarships" / "Scholarships" / "Apply Online Now" to reach the online application portal and begin the registration and application process. If this is your first visit to the site, you will need to "Create an Account." If this is a return visit, enter your email address and password. Choose the appropriate application from the menu.

APPLICATION DEADLINE March 15

YOUR APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE

- Transcript of most recent grades
- List of extracurricular activities (downloadable form online)
- At least one reference letter from teacher, community leader, or employer

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- 1) Candidates for this scholarship must meet the following requirements:
 - Parent must be employed by Pukall Lumber Company (student must be a dependent child)
 - Demonstrate financial need
 - Demonstrate a solid work ethic
 - Accepted at an accredited college, university, technical school, or certificate program in any field of study
 - Although academic achievement is not a qualification for the award, the student should have maintained at least a 2.0 GPA in the last two semesters of study

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

2) A second scholarship is available to:

- A graduating Lakeland Union High School senior / or recent LUHS graduate
- Planning to enroll / or currently enrolled in the Wood Technology or Wood Science Program (most likely at NTC in Antigo)

In both selection processes, weight will be placed on demonstration of a solid work ethic, through participation in activities in school and the community, including work.

ANNOUNCEMENT

Scholarship recipients will be announced through the company's communication methods. If possible, the recipients will be recognized at their school's award ceremonies in the spring.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will receive a congratulatory letter from the Community Foundation after the award announcement, instructing them on how to receive their scholarship funding. The student must provide proof of registration to the Community Foundation office for payment to be initiated. The Foundation will make payment directly to the college or university the student is attending.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Recipients are asked to acknowledge the scholarship by sending a thank you note to the donors directly to the Pukall Lumber Foundation.
