APPLICATION PROCESS

Apply online by visiting our website at cfoncw.org. Click on "Grants & Scholarships" / "Scholarships" / "Apply Online Now" to reach the online application portal and begin the registration and application process. If this is your first visit to the site, you will need to "Create an Account." If this is a return visit, enter your email address and password. Choose the appropriate application from the menu.

APPLICATION DEADLINE March 15

YOUR APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

- · Transcript of most recent grades
- · List of excurricular activities (downloadable form online)
- Two reference letters

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- · Graduating high school senior from the Wausau School District (including Wausau East, Wausau West High Schools, or Enrich Excel Achieve Learning Academy) in the high school credit program;
- · Child or grandchild of a current or retired employee of the Wausau School District classification: "Administrative and Educational Support Employees;"
- · Preference will be given students in the lower 75% of their graduating class;
- · Student can pursue a post-secondary education in any field of study (could be college, university, technical school, CNA, beauty culture school, trucking school, etc.)
- · Financial need is a consideration, but will not be the sole deciding factor.

ANNOUNCMENT

The recipients will be announced at their high school senior awards ceremonies in the spring.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The recipient will receive a congratulatory letter from the Community Foundation after the awards ceremony, instructing them on how to receive their scholarship funding. The student must provide proof of registration to the Community Foundation office for payment to be initiated. The Foundation will make payment directly to the school the student is attending in the fall.
