APPLICATION DEADLINE

First business day of February, April, June, August, October, and December.

Applicants will be notified of action taken on requests once the selection committee has reviewed their proposal.

GRANT RANGE

Generally \$500 - \$5,000

Grant recipients are asked to acknowledge the gift as a grant from the Wausau & Marathon County Parks & Recreation Foundation Fund.
