Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Demonstrating an understanding of the labor movement
- Reflecting a record of academic achievement and extracurricular involvement, with an emphasis on leadership
- Demonstrating financial need
- Preference will be given to students who plan to have a career within the labor movement
