## FUND BACKSTORY . . .

The Bradley Foundation Scholarship was established by John and Elizabeth (Betty) Bradley to benefit graduates of Antigo Senior High School, the alma mater of their eight children. The scholarship reflects the Bradleys' deep commitment to education, community service, and the Antigo area they called home.

John Bradley was a proud World War II veteran and graduate of the Wisconsin Institute of Mortuary Science (now Milwaukee Area Technical College). After completing his education, he returned to Antigo and founded the Bradley Funeral Home, which became a respected local institution under his care. Beyond his professional life, John was deeply involved in the community, serving in multiple fraternal and veterans' organizations and on the board of directors of the Community Health Foundation.

Elizabeth "Betty" Bradley, a Lawrence University graduate, began her career as a social worker before dedicating herself to raising their family and supporting numerous community causes. Her compassion and leadership were evident through her volunteer work with local nonprofits and her instrumental role in founding LeRoyer Hospice at Aspirus Langlade Hospital. In recognition of her lifelong service and dedication to others, Betty was named Antigo Chamber of Commerce Citizen of the Year in 1992.

Together, John and Betty exemplified a spirit of service, compassion, and civic responsibility. Through the Bradley Foundation Scholarship, their legacy continues - supporting the educational dreams of Antigo's young people and inspiring future generations to lead lives of purpose and community involvement.
