### FUND BACKSTORY . . .

Mr. Wrench's career was highlighted by his sense of honor and commitment, leadership, and service within the communities he resided. He became president and a member of the Board of Directors of Wisconsin Fuel and Light Company on March 1, 1946, and served as Chairman of the Board from 1982 to 1991. He remained active on the board of directors after 1991.

Mr. Wrench took pride in being a "third generation gas man," echoing the career path of both his father and grandfather. A respected leader in the industry, he served on the board of the Wisconsin Utilities Association for more than 30 years. He also served in leadership roles in many professional organizations. In addition to his involvement in the natural gas industry, he remained active in his community, where he served in leadership roles on numerous boards.



Education was important to Mr. Wrench, whose own was interrupted from 1943 – 1946 when he served for three years in the U.S. Army Signal Corps. In the spirit of leadership and community service that marked his career, the Harry K. Wrench, Jr. Memorial College Scholarship Fund was established to assist in the educational plans of promising youth from the communities served by Wisconsin Fuel and Light
